

DIRECTIONS TO BOCA DE LOS PALMAS - ROUTE 1

- * When you get into downtown Centro San Jose Del Cabo there is a tree lined median down the center of the main boulevard. About the middle of the boulevard you will see the Tropicana Hotel and Restaurant to your left. Go about two blocks, (you will be going East). You will see sign #1 on the right hand side that says Pueblo La Playa. Turn LEFT crossing on coming traffic.
- * You will see sign #2, Puerto Los Cabos, with 4 listings the last being Laguna Hills. Go straight out the paved road until you come to a traffic circle of sorts.
- * You will see sign #3, the same Puerto Los Cabos. Follow the arrow to Laguna Hills, which will take you partially around the circle and up the hill.
- * As you come to the bottom of the hill there will be sign # 4, the same Puerto Los Cabos.
- * Follow the arrow again to Laguna Hills. You will need to go around the backside of the circle to the LEFT. You will then see a black and white sign #5, with the listings of East Cape Road, Zacatitos, Buzzards, etc.
- * Go straight, following the paved road until you come to another small circle with sign # 6, that says Zacatitos, Buzzards, El Encanto. Turn RIGHT, and go to the end of the paved road. You will see Buzzards to your right, you want to turn LEFT.
- * The adventure starts now. Up to Buzzards is about 3 miles. Just stay on the dirt road. We are 13 miles from the Buzzards intersection.
- * As you drive through Zacatitos, toward the end of the development you will see a building to your right, which looks like it is constructed of rusted metal. Just beyond that you will see a Y in the road. Stay to the right on the ocean side.
- * You will pass another landmark.
- * The next landmark about 4 miles is a house with a red and white telephone tower. There are several large homes in this area. We are 5 miles from this point.
- * You know you are on the right track when you see a house with a lighthouse type tower.
- * Then you will see a house further along of multi colors. We are then only a few miles away.
- * Just 1/4 of a mile from our house you will see an entrance to a development called Bahia Terranova.
- * We are next, all by ourselves around the corner and sitting on the beach. A white complex with palm frond roofs.
